(i) P-03-153 Celf Corff

Geiriad y ddeiseb

'Rydym yn galw ar Gynulliad Cenedlaethol Cymru i roi cyfngiadau ar yr oed y gall plentyn dan oed gael celf corff. Dylid cyfyngu'r oed ar gyfer celf corff, ar wahân i'r clustiau a'r trwyn, i 16 oed'

Cynigiwyd y ddeiseb gan y Cynghorydd Russell Down a chasglodd 14 o lofnodion.

Gwybodaeth ychwanegol (cyflenwyd gan y Deisebydd - Saesneg yn unig)

'There are no legal restrictions on the age at which you can have your ears or other body parts pierced. However, some establishments may operate their own informal guidelines on obtaining parental consent. I am asking for a change in law to place restrictions on the age at which a minor can have body piercing. The age for body piercings other than the ears and nose should be regulated to the age of 16 years.'

(ii) P-03-185 Cynllun adfywio Llanilltud Fawr

Geiriad y ddeiseb

'Rydym yn galw ar Lywodraeth Cynulliad Cymru i gefnogi apêl cynllun adfywio Heol Boerton yn nhref hanesyddol Llanilltud Fawr, sef canolfan dysgu cyntaf Prydain.'

Cynigiwyd y ddeiseb gan y Cynghorydd Russell Down a chasglodd 498 o lofnodion.

Gwybodaeth ychwanegol (cyflenwyd gan y Deisebydd - Saesneg yn unig)

'The Boerton Road Public Realm Regeneration Project was submitted as a project by Creative Rural Communities, the Rural regeneration section of the Vale of Glamorgan Council, as part of the Rural Development Plan 2007- 13

This was a project focussing on major improvements to the Boerton Road shopping precinct in Llantwit Major, focussing on the public areas. It received strong community support, and in many ways was considered to be the flagship major project for the Local Development Strategy.

A number of reasons have been given in the rejection letter, and Officers are appealing against the rejection as currently progressing. The Vale had submitted 14 projects for grant aid, but only 11 were accepted by the Welsh Assembly Government. With millions of pounds being pumped into the regeneration of urban areas of the Vale, particularly Barry, Llantwit Major should not miss out on this important funding.'
