Research Funding

12. Bethan Jenkins: Will the First Minister provide an outline of the process for providing research funding to Welsh universities. OAQ(3)3496(FM)

The First Minister (Carwyn Jones): Research in universities in Wales is funded through the dual support system. The Higher Education Funding Council for Wales allocates grant funding, calculated by formula, which supports the research infrastructure, while the UK Research Councils and other bodies fund specific projects and programmes, usually on a competitive basis.

'One Wales' Programme

13. Peter Black: Will the First Minister make a statement on the completion of the One Wales programme. OAQ(3)3487(FM)

The First Minister: The huge majority of the commitments in our programme have already been delivered. Our final update of this Assembly term will show the good progress being made towards completing those few that remain, as planned.
