## **Purpose**

- 1.1 This paper provides suggestions from The Chartered Institute of Environmental Health on the possible terms of reference for the Inquiry.
  - 2. The Terms of Reference should include the following:
  - What caused the outbreak?
  - Could anything have been done that would have prevented such an outbreak, and if so, by whom?
  - Could anything have been done to reduce the spread of the outbreak, and if so, by whom?
  - The value, if any, to local authorities of the audits conducted by the Food Standards Agency, given the delay in providing the audit reports;
  - Communication issues, particularly the putting of information that is was potentially subjudice into the public arena;
  - The priority and resources given to environmental health services in local authorities;
  - Any wider issues that have come to light as the result of the investigation such as product sourcing by the company likely to be the source of the outbreak and the effectiveness of the Farm to Fork regime;
  - School Meals procurement policies;
- 1.3 The suggested list is neither exhaustive nor exclusive.
