Cwmbran SDC is also part of the RISE network, using the research from the CARAL project we identified a need for adapted IT for people with a Visual Impairment,

Thanks to the RISE, ESF we were able to purchase the hard ware and soft ware to give people with VI the opportunity to learn and access IT qualifications.
