The employer and employee receive just enough help from a support organisation to ensure success

### Overview of Project Achievements

- A total of 147 young people participated within the project
- 100% received vocational profiling
- 96% participated in supported work placements
- 98% of participants improved their soft skills
- 89% achieved Open College Network Accreditation
- 41% achieved paid employment
