

- 92% of all completed enquiries due in August were completed to deadline (see Table 6.2).




Chart 2.4: All enquiries received and deadlines met




#### **Summary**

- This month shows a decrease in total visitor numbers of 45% over the same month last year and 12% for the year to date. (Table 7.1 in the Annex).
- There were no Plenary or Committee Meetings during August. (Table 7.2 in the Annex).
- Booked visits show an overall decrease of 23% for the month over the same month last vear. (Table 7.3 in the Annex).
- Casual visitors to the Pierhead Building decreased by 47% for the month though casual visitors to the Chamber increased by 186%. There were 171 visitors to the North Wales Office in Colwyn Bay. (Table 7.4 in the Annex).
- The 'Assembly at the Pierhead' shop shows decreased sales for the month compared to the same month last year. Total sales decreased by 34% and total customers 42% (Table 7.5 in the Annex).
- The regional teams attended 80 regional events attended by 1,789 people (Table 7.7 and 7.8 in the Annex). There have been 8 large-scale events held this month. (Table 7.9 and 7.10 in the Annex).
- There have been 330 requests for information to the call centre and 12 bookings taken (Tables 7.11 and 7.12 in the Annex).



#### Written translation:


- Demand for written translation remained at a level constant with that of July, despite the Assembly recess, due to an increase in the total words received from the Assembly Government compared with July.
- There was a significant downturn in the total words translated during August, mirroring the same trend as in August 2003. Whereas the output of the in-house team remained at a relatively high level despite annual and special leave commitments, there was a significant reduction in the external capacity available through external contractors.






