[3] **Michael German:** The role of this committee is to consider and report on the Proposed National Assembly for Wales (Legislative Competence) (Education) Order 2010.

The committee will conclude its work in January. We have had informal discussions on our approach to the scrutiny of the Order. We consider that the terms of reference should be to look at the general principles of the proposed Order and whether legislative competence in the area identified in matters 5.2A, 5.2B and 5.2C should be conferred on the Assembly, and to look at whether the terms of the proposed Order are too broadly or too narrowly defined. Are Members content with the terms of reference? I see that you are.

[4] It was also suggested that, based around those terms of reference for the committee's scrutiny, we issue a general call for evidence, invite written submissions from specific consultees, which will be done next week, and that we take oral evidence in the weeks that follow from some of those consultees. Are Members content with that approach? I see that you are.
