I am currently studying for a MSc in Sustainable Food and Natural Resources and writing my dissertation on the subject of "barriers, both perceived and actual to livestock and dairy farmers selling local and direct". As I live in Ceredigion I will be looking particularly at the area of West Wales. One of my major areas of concern is particularly related to the lack of local abattoirs and the effects of large meat processing plants. This has been highlighted particularly by the recent out breaks of Covid 19 on Anglesey and in Wrexham at large processing plants. This has shown the fragility of a system lacking more local facilities.
