The First Minister (Carwyn Jones): The Welsh Government will expect local authorities to plan effectively for statutory Welsh-medium provision, based on information regarding parental demand. Steps are also being taken to improve the planning of Welsh-medium and bilingual provision for students aged between 14 and 19, students who receive education and training through work-based learning and those in higher education.
