The Minister for Housing, Regeneration and Heritage (Huw Lewis): The Welsh Government remains committed to ensuring young people are able to access a range of sporting opportunities as part of the curriculum, after school and within their communities. Programmes such as Dragon Sport, 5x60 and free swimming are in place to encourage participation in sport.

Mae swm o £33.976 miliwn yn cael ei ddarparu yn 2012-13 i helpu i gyflawni'r blaenoriaethau hyn.

Huw Lewis: Welsh Government support for the arts is channelled through the Arts Council of Wales. The strategic priorities for support are determined by the Welsh Government, in consultation with ACW, and are set out in my annual remit letter. In 2012-23, £33.976 million is being provided to help deliver these priorities.
