The Minister for Local Government and Government Business (Lesley Griffiths): Our programme for government sets out our plans for supporting the delivery of efficient and effective services that meet the needs of people in Wales. Last week's passing of the Local Government (Democracy) (Wales) Bill underlined our commitment to this approach. This is an approach of supporting strong local democracy and accountability, services that are always seeking to improve, the effective use of funding and public services that work effectively together.

Senior Officers' Pay

Lesley Griffiths: The setting of senior officers' pay remains the responsibility of each local authority. The Government amendment to the Local Government (Democracy) (Wales) Bill agreed by the Assembly introduces a check measure through the independent remuneration panel to avoid the setting of unreasonable and unjustified pay awards for the chief executive and sets the framework for pay of those senior officers sitting below the chief executive.
