Dear Llyr,


Following the devastating flooding across Wales over the weekend, and in particular Rhondda Cynon Taf in my electoral region of South Wales Central, I am writing to ask the Climate Change, Environment and Infrastructure Committee to undertake an inquiry into the Welsh Government and relevant agencies' responses to the experiences and aftermath of Storm Dennis in 2020.

I would like to ask the Committee to investigate the following:

1. What actions were recommended following Storm Dennis to improve the Welsh Government and all relevant agencies' future responses?
2. How these recommendations informed the Welsh Government and its relevant agencies' strategies in preparation for and in response to Storm Bert?

As I am sure you will agree, it is essential that the people of Wales have full confidence in the Welsh Government's ability to respond effectively to such incidents and the destruction that it causes in communities. I would urge the committee to undertake this vital exercise to gain answers for those affected by the devastation of Storm Bert across Wales.
